

One-Bedroom Public Housing Waiting List St. Louis Park, MN

Online applications will be available:
Monday, June 29, 2026 at 8 a.m. through Wednesday, July 1, 2026 at 4 p.m.

Applications will be accepted online only during this period at <https://housing.slpmn.us>. Translation is available in 60 different languages. **Applications will not be available in the Housing Authority (HA) offices, and fax or e-mail requests will not be accepted. The HA will not provide telephone assistance for applications.** Applicants needing a reasonable accommodation should submit a written request to the HA at 5005 Minnetonka Blvd, St. Louis Park, MN 55416. Computers for public use are available at public libraries and may be available at other community organizations.

The Public Housing Program provides clean, safe and affordable living environments for eligible low-income individuals and families. Those eligible for public housing pay 30% of their adjusted income for rent.

Income/Occupancy Eligibility

A minimum of one (1) and maximum of two (2) persons are allowed in a one-bedroom unit. Families with three or more people are not eligible.

Preference eligibility:

- Residency preference: Live, work, hired to work, or attend K-12 school in St. Louis Park, MN
- Elderly, near-elderly (age 50 or older) or disabled preference
- Veteran's or service person preference: Veteran or member of the armed services, widow/widower of veteran

Applicants can only be on **one** application. Applications must meet income, eligibility, and occupancy requirements. Applicants will be placed on the waiting list according to the preference(s) for which they qualify, and the date and time randomly applied to the applications.

If selected for the program, applicants will be notified in order of their placement on the waiting list to be screened for eligibility. Eligibility screening involves a rental screening process, including past rental history, criminal history check and review of credit history.
